# District 4-A1 Goals & Strategies for 2023-2024

#### **Leadership Goals**

- 1. Schedule and provide annual and regular training to support (60%) club officers, (100%) district cabinet, (30) Clubs and (250) Lions as identified in the District survey and requests for assistance each year beginning in May through June.
- 2. Develop a committee of trained Lions to work with the Global Membership Team to support Clubs as needed throughout the district.
- 3. Develop and have certified 15 to 20 Guiding Lions by September 2023 4 to 5 Guiding Lions in each Region to assist the Global Membership Team in working with Clubs in growing membership and service.

## **Service Goals**

- 1. 87% of 4-A1 Lion and Leo Clubs will report service by June 30, 2024 which is an increase over our previous goal of 80%.
- 2. 4-A1 will recruit 10 youth to send to other countries through the Lions Youth Exchange Program for 2024 exchange program.
- 3. 4-A1 will increase families hosting youth from other countries through the Lions Youth Exchange Program to serve 15 students in 2024.
- 4. Zone Chairs and VDGs will contact club officers and club members and assist Lions in reporting MMRs and service activities at least quarterly 7/1/2023 through 7/1/2024.

#### **LCIF Goals**

- 1. Increase Club LCIF donations by 10% over previous year (2023-24).
- 2. Thirty-five clubs donate to LCIF by June 30, 2024.

## Strategies to Meet Lions' and Clubs' Needs & Increase Service and Membership

- 1. Encourage and promote joint Club service projects.
- 2. Recognize Clubs service projects in newsletter, social media, and other types of communications.
- 3. Recognize Clubs at District meetings and at Club meetings for innovative service, initiative service, and joint club service.
- 4. Provide monthly District Member Orientation via Zoom and Regional in-person sessions.
- 5. Invite new members to training sessions, Zone and District meetings, and 4-A1 Convention.
- 6. Connect new members with service projects that match his/her passion via Club, Zone, Region, and District options.
- 7. Assist new members in starting a new service project as needed (Club, Zone, Region, and District options).
- 8. Identify ways to start new Clubs in District 4-A1.
- 9. Assist 5 10 Clubs in using Meet-and-Greet to build membership.
- 10. Identify 5-10 Clubs that want help in growing membership.
- 11. Start 2 Club Branches or Club Branch Specialty Clubs
- 12. Start 1 new Club in Planada.

The goals and strategies will be reviewed and adjusted, at least semi-annually, to meet the needs of Lions, Leos and Clubs going forward. With your continued input, 4-A1 will work to meet the needs of you - our members, and support your efforts to serve the needs in our local and worldwide communities.
